**6. Caloundra Info and Climate:**

Caloundra at the Sunshine Coast is only one hour drive north of Brisbane. Caloundra is a region that stretches from the cool green of the Hinterland Mountains to the crisp blue and white of the ocean and beaches. Caloundra has spectacular beaches, quaint country villages, lush rainforest beauty, magical mountain charm, multi award winning dining, views that stretch for miles and sun filled days. July is a cooler month with a pleasant 19 –22 degree Celsius. Caloundra has given its full support to the organising committee of the world championships.

**7. Championship Package and Discount Card:**

For All Participants (Competitors, Coaches, Umpires, Supporters, Team Doctors, Press Agents, NGB Members, VIPs, and Others) the Organising Committee has pre-organised Lodging and Board at Several Hotels during the Championships, which must be booked through the Organising Committee.

**Payment** – A deposit of AUD \$200 to be paid on or before May 9<sup>th</sup> 2005, and the Final Payment to be paid in cash at the registration check in point, Caloundra Indoor Sports Stadium. **No** Travellers / Bank cheques, Visa, Master card, and Amex will be accepted.

**Countries/Participants NOT BOOKING** accommodation through the organising committee **MUST PAY** an accreditation fee of US\$150 per person to obtain the **ID CARD**. This includes all the items in the Championship Package above, excluding the Full Board, Accommodation and Meals.

### **8. Forms and Money: \*\*\*IMPORTANT\*\*\***

The **absolute deadline** for receiving all of the forms and money is **May 9<sup>th</sup> 2005**. In order to allocate your stadium seat at the championships and confirm your accommodation, Countries / Groups “**Must**” pay a non refundable deposit of AUD \$200 per person payable to **General Choi’s International Taekwondo Federation Australia Inc**. After this date, the Hotels will not be able to uphold the special rates. All Forms should be sent by mail along with Two Passport Photos (size 3cm x 4cm) for each competitor. Officials, Coaches, Umpires, VIP’s, President Team Doctor, Press Agents and supporters should

### **10. Arrivals:**

Countries / Groups must arrive on or before July 8<sup>th</sup> 2005. Those travellers entering Australia via Sydney and Melbourne can fly direct to the Sunshine Coast, and for those travellers entering via Brisbane, they can commute one hour north by local bus companies directly to the Caloundra Indoor Sports Stadium at the check in point for registration and allocation of accommodation. We recommend **Sun – Air Coaches** which have an office at the Brisbane Airport, departing hourly, the phone number is 0011 61 7 54782811 and email is [res@sunair.com.au](mailto:res@sunair.com.au). Countries / Groups arriving by Plane will need to forward Flight Details (One pickup and drop off per Country from the Sunshine Coast Airport July 8<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup>). Without this booking, any transfers are not possible by the Organising Committee and your own transport arrangements will need to be made. Other arrivals by your own means must all proceed to the meeting point at their designated time and location. The Meeting Point for accreditation and payment of all competitors/coaches, inscription fees and hotel accommodation will be at the Indoor Stadium. After this procedure, the group will be taken to their designated hotel. If arriving before the official arrival date, please contact the Organising Committee.

### **11. Visa:**

Countries requiring a Visa for Australia should contact the nearest Australian Consulate. In recent years, the Australia Ministry of Foreign Affairs has become stricter with regards to the issue of Entry Visas. The waiting period after application of Visas to Australia will vary depending upon the country from which the request is being made. It is strongly advised that you should apply at least **120 days** before arriving in Australia. If having any problems, please contact the 14<sup>th</sup> Senior World Championships Organising Committee.

### **12. Local Attractions:**

The organising committee has organised day trips to Aussie World, Australia Zoo, Underwater World, Dream World, Sea World, and Movie World. Bookings are available at the Caloundra Indoor Sports Stadium on Registration.

### **13. National Anthem and National Flag:**

Every Country should provide Two (2) National Flags and their National Anthem on Compact Disc. The size of the flag should be approximately 100 cm x 150 cm. Timing of Anthem and hoist of flags will be within 30 to 45 sec. Please send these to the Organising Committee President before May 9<sup>th</sup> 2005.

**14. Inscription Fee:**

Individual Competitors must pay an Inscription Fee of US\$100 at the Check-in point of Caloundra Indoor Sports Stadium; method of payment is Cash Only.

**15. Umpires:**

Countries who are participating in the Championships are required to bring one A Class ITF Qualified Umpire who is a 4<sup>th</sup> Degree or Above. The Organising Committee will pay for One Umpire per Country with accommodation of 8 days, 7 nights on a double, triple, share room basis, including meals, (excluding drinks) from the morning of July 9<sup>th</sup> to lunch July 14<sup>th</sup>. Umpires must attend the Umpire Meeting dressed as written in the Umpires Rules. Umpires will be required to perform their duties as scheduled. The organising committee has the right to dismiss any Umpires who do not abide by the work schedules or guidelines and as such will have to pay their full accommodation and meals. Any other Umpires wishing to attend the Championships must pay their own Hotel Accommodation.

**16. Coaches:**

For Individual and/or Team Events, only one coach is allowed in the square. He or She must wear a Tracksuit with Gym Shoes. He or She is the only one allowed to present an Official Protest at a tax of US\$100. A Maximum of Four Coaches is allowed per Country at an entry fee of US\$50 per individual. All Coaches must attend the Draw and Coaches meeting at the Stadium, payment on arrival at the meeting point.

**17. Participation Insurance:**

The Participating National Federation is obliged to arrange the insurance of its own members. The Organising Committee bears no responsibility for any injury or loss for participants during the Championships.

**18. Health Care/Medical Services:**

First Aid will be at the disposal of all participants during the World Championships.

**19. Competition Format:**

Single Elimination System

**20. Competition Rules:**

ITF Tournament and Umpire Rules will apply for Patterns, Sparring, Special Technique, Power Breaking and Self-Defence routine. The current rules are available for download from the International Taekwon-do Federation website, [www.internationaltaekwon-dofederation.com](http://www.internationaltaekwon-dofederation.com).

### 21. Qualifications for the Participants:

All NGB's of the International Taekwon-do Federation can take part in these Championships; each competitor must be a member of their NGB and possess an ITF Black Belt Degree Certificate and National Passport.

There will be only One Competitor for each category/division per country. Team events may consist of individuals outside individual events. The same team must be fielded for Patterns, Sparring, Special Techniques and Power Breaking.

### 22. Competitor Dress Code:

The Official ITF Dobok with the Country printed on the back under the Tree, the Competitors Number will be below the belt on the back of the Dobok Jacket. Sponsorship logos may be on the right side of the chest at a recommended size of 10cm by 5cm. Flag to be stitched to the right sleeve on the side approximately 2cm below the shoulder seam.

Sparring Safety Equipment – Prior to each event each participant must be equipped with Red or Blue Protective Gloves and Boots according to their competition colour.

### **23. Awards for Participants:**

All participants will receive a Certificate of Participation signed by the ITF President, Umpiring Chairperson and President of the Organising Committee. Finalists of specified divisions and categories will receive Diplomas and Medals. Officials, Coaches and Judges will receive Medals.

#### **Award Presentation –**

Individual – First Place Gold, Second Place Silver and Third Place Two Bronze, one for each semi finalist competitor.

Teams – 6 Gold, 6 Silver and 12 Bronze, one for each team member.

### **24. Ceremonies:**

For the Opening and Closing Ceremonies the ITF dobok is normally worn or a tracksuit representing your countries colour. No participants in the parade are permitted to carry cameras, banners, flags etc. on the field during the Opening/Closing Ceremonies. Each Country must submit their participants and officials to represent their country during the official parade.

**Opening Ceremony** – The official opening ceremony will take place on Sunday July 10<sup>th</sup> 2005 at 09.30hrs in the Caloundra Indoor Sports Stadium. After the parade, there will be an Australian Aboriginal cultural display of 45 minutes, and then a 45 minute demonstration by the Korean Demonstration Team.

**Closing Ceremony** – The official closing ceremony will take place on Thursday July 14<sup>th</sup> 2005 just after the medal presentation. During the closing ceremony the ITF Championship flag will be given to the next host country of the next 15<sup>th</sup> Senior World Taekwon-Do championships.

### **25. Party:**

The party will be held on Thursday July 14<sup>th</sup> at the Aussie World Tourist attraction at 20.00hrs. Dress code is smart casual, there will be live entertainment, and the venue is fully licensed. Party til late. The party is free entry to all ID card holders.
